*"Then Joshua blessed him, and he gave Hebron to Caleb the son of Jephunneh for an inheritance. Therefore Hebron became the inheritance of Caleb the son of Jephunneh the Kenizzite to this day, because he wholly followed the Lord, the God of Israel."*

*Joshua 14:13-14*

#### **Discuss**

1. Why do we often think of God's blessing as something that is full of peace, good feelings, and no strife?
2. How would you describe Caleb's relationship with the Lord? (Joshua 14:8-9)
3. What are some reasons people often look at these qualities such as what Caleb had as deserving God's goodness and blessing?
4. Caleb was blessed, but he still had a lot of work in front of him in order to attain the land as seen in the following chapter (Joshua 15:13-14). Based on the message, how does this change your perspective of what "blessing" means.
5. Why do you think some of our greatest blessings are trials? (James 1:12)
6. Galatians 3:13-14 is a great example of how this world was blessed, but that blessing required a great sacrifice. What are some examples you've seen of blessing requiring sacrifice?
