#### **Discuss**

1. John 5:1-17 speaks about the invalid at the pool of Bethesda. When Jesus healed him why did He say to "go and sin no more"?
2. Why should we as Christians go to our brothers and sisters in Christ when they are sinning? What is the difference between judging and being judgmental, and what should our attitude be towards those sinning?
3. Why did Jesus decide not to condemn the woman caught in adultery? What was His primary concern in dealing with her?
4. Romans 6:1-14 speaks of the ability that God has given us to "drop it" (drop the sin). What are we saying when we say that sin still has control over us?
5. How do we "drop it"?
6. What is the beauty of God's grace when it comes to our sin?
