#### **Discuss**

2. What might be some reasons it could be difficult to listen?
3. Have you ever been at a point where you just didn't want to "drop the net"? What was the benefit of the disciples listening to Jesus tell them to drop their nets (Luke 5:5-7)? What was the benefit of you dropping yours?
4. Why is faith not simply optimism? What is faith?
5. Why is it worth the pain to have both discipline and faith when going through a difficult situation?
6. How do the smaller tasks in life prepare you to follow Christ with the greater things?
