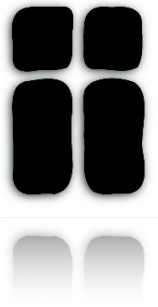


Small Group Guide

From the sermon: Numbered - Shoulders



Then the Lord said to Moses, "Accept these from them, that they may be used in the service of the tent of meeting, and give them to the Levites, to each man according to his service."

Numbers 7:4-5

Discuss

1. As you look around and see what God has given to others, why is it so easy to fall into the trap of being discontent with what you have/don't have (both material and immaterial)?
2. Similarly, why should we never feel as if we are better than someone else because of what God has blessed us with (again, both material and immaterial)?
3. Read Numbers 7:1-9. Why were some of the Levites given more oxen and wagons than others? Why were the sons of Kohath given none?
4. Even though the sons of Kohath were given nothing and had to carry the holy things on their shoulders what was their true blessing in this?
5. God gives to those according to what He has called them to do. How should your attitude towards what you have or don't have?
6. We are all a part of the body of Christ, and each person has their specific God-given role based on talents, abilities, and gifts. After hearing this message, where do you best fit in based on the things God has given you?
