#### **Discuss**

1. As a result of listening to the message how do you determine what a significant event in your life really is?
2. When Jesus came into Jerusalem there was "pomp and circumstance". But when He went to the cross the mood was quite the opposite. Why was the walk to the cross so much more significant than the entrance into Jerusalem?
3. Why might you often look for the movement of God in the exciting times?
4. We often experience disruptions, heartaches, and obstacles. Why might God use these times to move in our lives? (Romans 5:3-4)
5. God knows what we are going to experience. Read Zechariah 11:12-13 as well as Mark 14:10-11, 43-50. Discuss the importance of this prophecy fulfilled in Mark.
6. Was there a greater purpose behind all of the backroom deals Judas engaged in? How did God use what was so horrible to bring about what was so incredible?
