Discuss

1. Job enters the discussion with God, thinking he has the strength and the right to stand before Him and question Him. How does the lesson of Behemoth and Leviathan cause Job to abandon his questions?
2. Why do you think we often want the world to stop for us when we are struggling through a rough time?
3. God used Behemoth and Leviathan to show how great His power was to Job, and it humbled his heart. How has God shown you his power and humbled your heart?
4. Entitlement is nothing new. How does the lesson of Behemoth and Leviathan speak against human entitlement?
5. What circumstances have happened in your life that have taught you that you are not in control? What ways did that change you?

Pray that God helps you understand there is a bigger picture to your suffering, and pray that you continue to trust Him no matter what the circumstance.
