Discuss

1. God has given us the privilege of writing the story of our lives by letting us use the gifts and talents he has given us. Do you know the gifts and talents God has given you? Go around the room and share them with each other. How are you using them/or not using them?
2. What about the gift of faith in Jesus Christ? Why should we not bury it?
3. How do we guard our hearts and minds when the voices around us try to deceive us from believing what is true? (Proverbs 4:20-27)
4. Don't bury your uniqueness. Why is it so important to be who God uniquely made you to be? (Psalm 139:14-15, 1 Corinthians 12:6-10)
5. Don't bury your parents. Why is it important not to discount the wisdom of your parents/older mentors in your life? (Proverbs 23:22-25)
6. How can you begin writing a better, more God-honoring story of your life? What do you need to do differently now?
